- VITA 1.5, 2eSST - 30 month period
- Dec 1, 1999 thru May 1, 2002
- Changes through VSO task group balloting process



VITA 20, Conduction Cooled PMC

- Ballot List Compiled - 8 Balloters
- Ballot Opened - Mar 14, 2001
- Ballot Closes - Jun 15, 2001




VITA 30.1, 2mm Equipment Practice for Conduction Cooled Euroboard Systems

- Ballot Opened - 12/14/00
- Ballot Closes - 3/16/00
- Public Review
 - Started - Jan 12, 2001
 - Closes - Mar 13, 2001
- Balloters - 8
- Ballots Returned - 7
 - 6 Affirmative
 - 1 Negative



Drafts in Canvass Ballot Review

- VITA 29, PC•MIP
 - 15 balloters
 - 14 ballots returned
 - 12 affirmative (some with comments)
 - 2 negative - re: front panel mechanicals
- Extension applied for and granted
 - June 7, 2001



Standards Up for 5 Year Reaffirmation/Revision/Withdrawal

- Approved in 1995
 - ANSI/VITA 1-1994, VME64
 - ANSI/VITA 6-1994, SCSSA
- Approved in 1996
 - ANSI/VITA 3, Board Level Live Insertion
 - ANSI/VITA 4, IP Modules
 - ANSI/VITA 13, HIC Pin Assignment



IEEE P1386 Update

- Forwarded to IEEE for approval
- VITA has agreed to coordinate future changes to CMC and PMC standards.



IEEE Reaffirmation Ballots

- IEEE 1101.2, Conduction Cooled Euroboards
 - Cover letter, etc provide to IEEE
 - Ballot should start soon?
- IEEE 1302 Ballot has started.



IEEE 1014, 32 Bit VMEbus

- From Don Wright, MSC Chair: The IEEE staff recommends we simply leave 1014 in place for now. When the new ANSI/VITA standard is complete we can either have a vote to withdraw 1014 or if we are real close to December 2002, then we can wait for administrative withdrawal of it.
